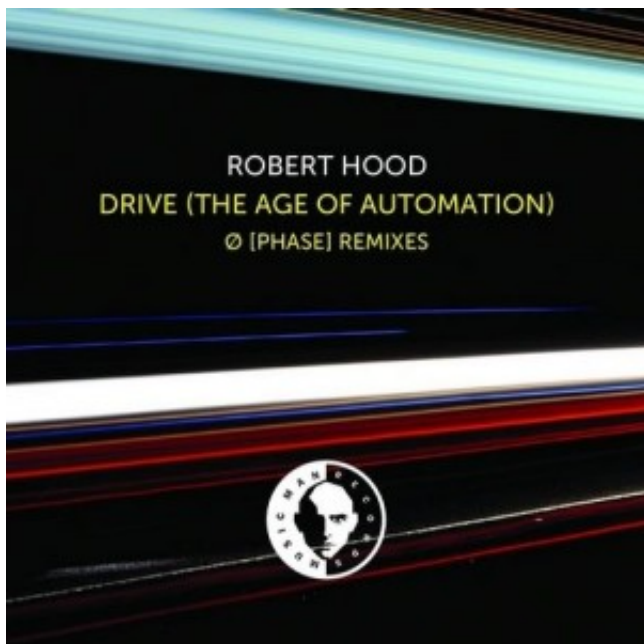
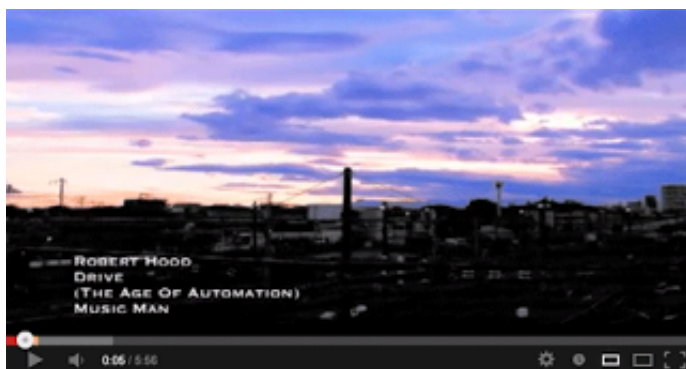


Top Cat
